Authorizing bonds for transportation funding.

1 AN ACT Relating to authorizing bonds for transportation funding; 2 adding new sections to chapter 47.10 RCW; and declaring an emergency.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. In order to provide funds necessary for 4 5 the location, design, right-of-way, and construction of selected 6 projects or improvements that are identified as forward Washington 7 projects or improvements in an omnibus transportation appropriations act, there shall be issued and sold upon the request 8 of the 9 department of transportation a total of \$5,500,000,000 of general 10 obligation bonds of the state of Washington.

11 NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. Upon the request of the department of transportation, as appropriate, the state finance committee shall 12 supervise and provide for the issuance, sale, and retirement of the 13 14 bonds in this act in accordance with chapter 39.42 RCW. Bonds 15 authorized by this act shall be sold in the manner, at time or times, 16 in amounts, and at the price as the state finance committee shall 17 determine. No bonds may be offered for sale without prior legislative 18 appropriation of the net proceeds of the sale of the bonds.

19The state finance committee shall consider the issuance of short-20term obligations in lieu of long-term obligations for the purposes ofCode Rev/AI:jlb1S-2573.2/21 2nd draft

1 more favorable interest rates, lower total interest costs, and 2 increased marketability and for the purpose of retiring the bonds 3 during the life of the project for which they were issued.

<u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 3. The proceeds from the sale of bonds authorized by section 1 of this act shall be deposited in the forward Washington account in the motor vehicle fund. The proceeds shall be available only for the purposes enumerated in section 1 of this act, for the payment of bond anticipation notes, if any, and for the payment of bond issuance costs, including the costs of underwriting.

10 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 4. Bonds issued under the authority of this section and sections 1 through 3, 5, and 6 of this act shall 11 distinctly state that they are a general obligation of the state of 12 Washington, shall pledge the full faith and credit of the state to 13 14 the payment of the principal thereof and the interest thereon, and shall contain an unconditional promise to pay such principal and 15 interest as the same shall become due. The principal and interest on 16 the bonds shall be first payable in the manner provided in this 17 section and sections 1 through 3, 5, and 6 of this act from the 18 proceeds of the state excise taxes on fuel imposed by chapter 82.38 19 RCW and vehicle-related fees imposed under Title 46 RCW that 20 constitute license fees for motor vehicles required to be used for 21 highway purposes. Proceeds of these excise taxes and vehicle-related 22 23 fees are hereby pledged to the payment of any bonds and the interest thereon issued under the authority of this section and sections 1 24 through 3, 5, and 6 of this act, and the legislature agrees to 25 continue to impose these excise taxes on fuel and vehicle-related 26 27 fees in amounts from such sources sufficient to pay, when due, the principal and interest on all bonds issued under the authority of 28 this section and sections 1 through 3, 5, and 6 of this act. 29

30 Sec. 5. (1) Both principal and interest on the NEW SECTION. bonds issued for the purposes of this section and sections 1 through 31 4 and 6 of this act shall be payable from the highway bond retirement 32 33 fund. The state finance committee may provide that a special account be created in the fund to facilitate payment of the principal and 34 interest. The state finance committee shall, on or before June 30th 35 of each year, certify to the state treasurer the amount required for 36 principal and interest on the bonds in accordance with the bond 37 S-2573.2/21 2nd draft Code Rev/AI:jlb 2

1 proceedings. The state treasurer shall withdraw revenues from the 2 forward Washington account in the motor vehicle fund and deposit in 3 the highway bond retirement fund, or a special account in the fund, 4 such amounts, and at such times, as are required by the bond 5 proceedings.

6 (2)(a) Any funds required for bond retirement or interest on the 7 bonds authorized by this section and sections 1 through 4 and 6 of 8 this act shall be taken from that portion of the motor vehicle fund 9 that results from the imposition of excise taxes on fuel and vehicle-10 related fees, and that is distributed to the forward Washington 11 account in the motor vehicle fund.

12 (b) Funds required shall never constitute a charge against any 13 other allocations of fuel tax and vehicle-related fee revenues to the 14 state, counties, cities, and towns unless the amount arising from 15 excise taxes on fuel and vehicle-related fees distributed to the 16 forward Washington account described in (a) of this subsection proves 17 insufficient to meet the requirements for bond retirement or interest 18 on any such bonds.

19 (c) Any payments for bond retirement or interest on the bonds 20 taken from other revenues from the fuel taxes and vehicle-related 21 fees that are distributable to the state, counties, cities, and towns 22 shall be repaid from the first revenues from the fuel taxes and 23 vehicle-related fees distributed to the forward Washington account 24 described in (a) of this subsection not required for bond retirement 25 or interest on the bonds.

NEW SECTION. Sec. 6. Bonds issued under the authority of sections 1 through 5 of this act and this section and any other general obligation bonds of the state of Washington that have been or that may be authorized and that pledge fuel excise taxes and vehiclerelated fees for the payment of principal and interest thereon shall be an equal charge against the revenues from such fuel excise taxes and vehicle-related fees.

33 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 7. For purposes of sections 1 through 6 of 34 this act, "vehicle-related fees" means vehicle-related fees imposed 35 under Title 46 RCW that constitute license fees for motor vehicles 36 required to be used for highway purposes.

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<u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 8. Sections 1 through 7 of this act are each
added to chapter 47.10 RCW.

3 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 9. This act is necessary for the immediate 4 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of 5 the state government and its existing public institutions, and takes 6 effect immediately.

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
